

BUSINESS CLASS

We have intensive business Japanese courses, one in intermediate II level and one in advanced level. We offer these classes for those who want to learn business Japanese. Please inquire about the class at our office when you apply for the intensive course.

Kyoto is the city of traditional culture and study. 【Admission requirements】

1. Applicants are required to have college student visa status
2. Applicants are required to hold a bachelor's degree from 4-year college or university.
3. Applicants are required to have passed the 2nd grade of the Japanese Language Proficiency Test or have graduated from the Japanese department of university
4. Applicants are required to have business experience
5. Applicants must be able to satisfy the equivalent of all of the above qualifications.

【Class size】

Up to 13 students

【Course outline】

The course consists of the following three main subjects.

1. General Japanese
 - Advanced level Japanese required to conduct business in Japanese
 - Knowledge and use of honorific words
2. Business studies
 - Business socialising and conversation
 - Development of presentation and debate skills
 - Study of Japanese business culture and role plays
 - Talk with guest speakers
 - Company tours
3. Japanese culture and history
 - Japanese affairs
 - Kyoto's traditional culture
 - Japanese modern and contemporary culture
