

EVENING COURSE

For those people who work during the day and cannot attend the regular course, KJLS offers the evening course. Like the regular course, the evening course meets twice a week. Two lessons each class day, each lesson is 55 minutes.

Tuesday & Friday (Intermediate-I/II & Advanced)

Classes will not be held on October 12 and national holidays.
