

SUMMER INTENSIVE COURSE

This course is intended for those who wish to study during the summer holidays. It is an intensive class that meets 4 hours per day, 20 hours per week. In addition to regular classes, there will also be extra-curricular activities that offer students opportunities to experience Japanese culture. Please note that this course does not meet the qualifications for Japanese language “College Student” visa status. Those coming to Japan from abroad in order to enroll in this class should enter the country with a “Temporary Visitor” or similar visa.

Time period July 12 (Thursday) - August 8, 2012(Wednesday) [4 weeks]
*Although July 16(Mon) is a national holiday, classes will be held as usual.

Class levels Beginner (three levels), Intermediate (two levels), Advanced
*Student’s class level depends upon the result of placement test.

Beginner level

This course aims to develop the fundamental skills necessary for conversation about the students’ surroundings, using basic vocabulary and sentence patterns. Although the class emphasizes spoken conversation, students will also learn to read and write hiragana and katakana, and will study kanji characters that are necessary for their everyday life.

Intermediate level

This course will measure students’ knowledge of basic grammar patterns, add to their previous speaking and listening practice, cover reading comprehension of sentences with fairly difficult content, and develop a comprehensive, applied Japanese language ability for use in everyday life.

Advanced level

This course is intended for students with applied language ability who can read over 1000 kanji characters. Using newspaper and magazine articles as course materials, students will learn to grasp the content of relatively difficult Japanese and to express their own opinions.

Class hours 9:00 a.m. - 12:30 p.m. (45 minutes x 4)

Fees **Registration fee** ¥10,000
 Tuition ¥75,000
*Consumption tax is included in the fees above.

Class size 13 students (Class will be cancelled if fewer than 4 enroll.)

Application deadline June 8, 2012 (Friday)

*Accommodation arrangement request is due on May 31. Submit your completed application documents by the due date, stating clearly that you need an accommodation arrangement.

Notes Fees for the textbooks and other materials are additional.
Once classes are filled, no further applications will be accepted.
